## JR & SR BASEBALL INTER-LEAGUE PLAYING RULES 2010

The following interleague rules are in addition to the Junior / Senior League rulebook. They have been categorized in accordance to the rulebook.

### I. THE LEAGUE

1. District 27 shall govern the league.
2. Team Rosters, Birth Certificates, and three (3) proofs of residents must be submitted at the managers and coaches meeting.
3. All Stars: Any player who has participated as an eligible player in 60 percent of the regular season as of June 15, with the exception of middle school or the high school baseball season. Note: An eligible player is defined as having all his paper work turn in to District 27 no later than April 15.
4. 15 year olds are allowed to participate in the junior division.
  - a. Must be approved by District 27.
  - b. The 15 year old cannot pitch or catch.

### VI. PITCHERS –MEDICAL RELEASES

1. The team manager or coach must carry a player eligibility roster and team scorebook to each game.
  - a. The team manager or coach must carry medical releases at all times (Both game and practice, including borrowed player).
  - b. The Jr/Sr ADA **must** be notified of all borrowed players and **must** be replied to before that player can play (by text or phone).

- c. A borrowed player can not pitch or catch.

## **VII. SCHEDULE**

1. District 27 will make the schedule for the season and is subject to change by District only.
2. Two (2) - no shows without what I deem is proper notification, that team will be dropped from the schedule and its player will not be eligible for the all stars tournament.

## **XIV. FIELD DECORUM**

1. One adult coach **must** be in the dugout at all times
2. All players must remain inside the dugout when they are not actively engaged on the playing field
3. All carry in items must be kept inside the dugout...
4. Managers and coaches cannot warm up the pitcher.
5. Any altercation by a player and/or coach on or off the field will not be tolerated (verbal or physical).
6. District 27 reserves the right to discipline anyone who participates in the inter- league play.

## **1.00 OBJECTIVE OF THE GAME**

1. Players must not wear watches, rings, earrings, pins, jewelry or other metallic items.
2. Catcher must wear a catcher's helmet that meets Little League specifications (No skullcaps). Mask must have a dangling throat guard.

## **3.00 GAME PRELIMINARIES**

1. Both teams shall supply two new baseballs.
2. The home team is responsible for preparing the field.
  - a. Both teams shall break down the field after the game, unless there is a Game to follow.

- b. The host league must provide access to field preparation equipment to the Teams playing.
- c. The game umpire shall have final say as to field readiness.
- d. After the game both teams are responsible for cleaning their dugouts and stands.

## **4.00 STARTING AND ENDING GAME**

1. Weekday games will start at 5:00 PM unless otherwise posted on the schedule.
2. All games shall start when scheduled unless the game before delays the start.
3. **If, after 2 ½ hours of play, one team is ahead by ten or more runs, the Ten Run Rule (4.10e) shall apply.**
4. All games that require re-scheduling will be done so by the District 27.
5. A protest committee composed of District 27 Staff shall settle all protests.
6. If a player is ejected from a game, player will sit out the remainder of the game and will sit out the team's next game, on the bench in uniform.
  - a. An adult manager or coach ejected from a game must leave the field immediately and take no further part in that game. They may not sit in the stands or be near the field.
  - b. An adult manager or coach ejected, will sit out the teams next game, they may not sit in the stands or be near the field.  
NOTE: If the ejection is determined to have been flagrant a more severe penalty may be assessed.

## **9.00 UMPIRE**

1. The home team shall supply umpires unless District 27 has chosen to assign District 27 Umpires. A minimum of two umpires is preferred.
2. If home team supplies " **paid umpires**" and the visiting team does not show up, the visiting team will be responsible to reimburse the home team for the cost of the umpire (This will be handled though the district).
3. If no umpires show up both managers will umpire.

## **10.00 OFFICIAL SCORER**

1. Home team will be responsible to supply the official scorekeeper.

2. Before each game the official scorekeeper will receive both teams' lineups. Lineup must show first and last name and uniform number of each player.
3. Each team is responsible for keeping their pitching records. Pitching records must be signed off after each game by opposing manager.
4. Before each game the opposing manager may ask to see the pitching records.
5. Pitchers who deliver 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher.
6. A balk or illegal pitch, whether or not a pitch is actually delivered to a batter, counts as a pitch in determining the pitch count for that pitcher (New for the 2010 season).
7. Scorebooks subject to review by district personnel and must be turned in at certification to verify that the player participated in the proper amount of games.

## **LEAGUE PARTICIPATION**

Participation in District 27's Junior and Senior Baseball program is voluntary. Leagues that do choose to participate must agree to abide by these interleague playing rules. District 27 has the authority to discipline managers, coaches, players and leagues, any fan that is ejected from a game will not be allowed to attend that teams next game, if the offense that caused the ejection is deemed to be outside the policies of Little Leagues Baseball. District 27 may impose a harsher penalty.

District 27 also reserves the right of final approval of the leagues All Star manager and/or coaches.

District 27 reserves the right to make any changes necessary to administrate the program.
