DISTRICT 27 TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT
12 YEAR & UNDER – JUNIOR

Season: The season will start on Sunday, September 18, and end on November 20.

12 & U	Juniors
Games shall not be longer than 2 hours	Games shall not be longer than 2 1/2 hours

Umpires: Minimum of one umpire per game.
The “Home Team” listed on the playing schedule shall provide umpires.
If there are no umpires, managers will be required to umpire.

Balls: “Each Team”, as listed on the schedule, shall provide two (2) new baseballs.

Rules: Little League Baseball Inc. rulebook shall apply with the following exceptions:

- 1) Teams shall use continuous batting order. (4.04)
- 2) 5 run rule for each inning – When the 5 run scores Finish the play, and then change sides. Last inning is open for runs – the ump must agree that it is the final inning before inning begins.
- 3) Unlimited substitutions are allowed (and encouraged).
- 4) Maximum of two innings per pitcher in each game is allowed. (Jr three innings max)
- 5) If pitcher hits two batters, the pitcher will be replaced on the mound.
- 6) Both base coaches are to be players; adults may assist the players for training purposes.
- 7) No make-up games.
- 8) No protests – Report what you feel is a rule violation. It then will be reviewed and the proper person will be contacted. This is for instructional purposes.

Discipline: Discipline will be resolved on a case-by-case basis with District 27 making the decision.

Schedules: Each league is responsible to check the www.cad27.com web site to see if any changes have been made on rules and/or schedules. Deviation from the District 27 Schedule, without District 27 approval, is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.

Common Courtesy: If your team cannot field a team, please contact the proper District 27 Rep.

Bad Weather: All Levels can call - Jimmie L. Timms Cell: (310) 897-0701 to find out the game status.

The league where the game is to be played will determine if the field is in playing condition 1-½ hours before game time and call the cell number above.

Team Requests: Email your requests ASAP to proper District Rep. Include your level of play, name of manager, and information specific to the request.

Team managers shall have his/her team’s medical releases with them at all times.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in suspension or removal from T.A.D.
